Conditions of Entry

Dogs must have an AKC registration number and be at least one year of age on the day of the trial. Dogs may only run once per test. One dog per entry form per test. All entries must be accompanied cash or check to be valid. A returned check is not a valid entry. There will be a \$25 fee for a returned check. Entries that are incomplete, by phone, text, email or requesting signature will not be accepted.

Hours

Grounds will be available at 8:00 AM roll call begins at 8:30 AM for morning test and 30 minutes following the completion of the first trial for afternoon test. ***Early acceptance for members of the field committee may begin one-half hour prior to publish test hours.***

At roll call, all dogs will be examined and wicketed for height and for disqualifications. *Bitches known to be in season are not to be brought to the test. At inspection, bitches in season, lame and unfit dogs will be excused with entry refunded.*

Directions to Trial Site

From the East or West: Take I-40 to 52 North.
From Highway 52: Take Exit 123 (King/Tobaccoville).
Turn right at top of ramp. Con't through King.
After crossing Rail Road Tracks, Turn Left.
School on Right after Fire Department

Awards

DPCC will give a light blue ribbon for a passing run.
BOSS will give title ribbons and sponsor ribbons at each trial for: Road Runner, Turtle Ribbon, Chicken Ribbon, House Cat and Squirrel Ribbons. Fastest Doberman & Fastest Veteran Sat(AM) .
Boss will also sponsor 1-3 placements for Small, Med, and Large Dogs

Site Specifics

- This is a rain-or-shine outdoor event. Please plan accordingly.
- Please bring your own shade, chairs and water.
- The field has little shade and is fenced.
- An electronic timing system will be used.
- A gas powered, continuous loop, plastic strip lure machine will be used.
- The show grounds are not completely fenced.
- Bathrooms are available inside the school building.
- Dogs must be on lead or crated unless running. **NO FLEXIE** leads on show grounds or inside the building
- A \$5 fine will be assessed for any loose dog on the field not competing or for not picking up after your dog.
- You are responsible for controlling your dog(s) and children.
- Any person, upon reasonable complaint, may be asked to leave the grounds of the field trial by the Field Committee and may be disciplined by the AKC.
- The Doberman Pinscher Club of Charlotte, Brylin Farm or Brylin Obedience Specialty School and its members will not be held responsible for any accidents at this event.
- All AKC Rules regarding sportsmanship and conduct apply.

Dogs are to be warmed up before and cooled down after running.

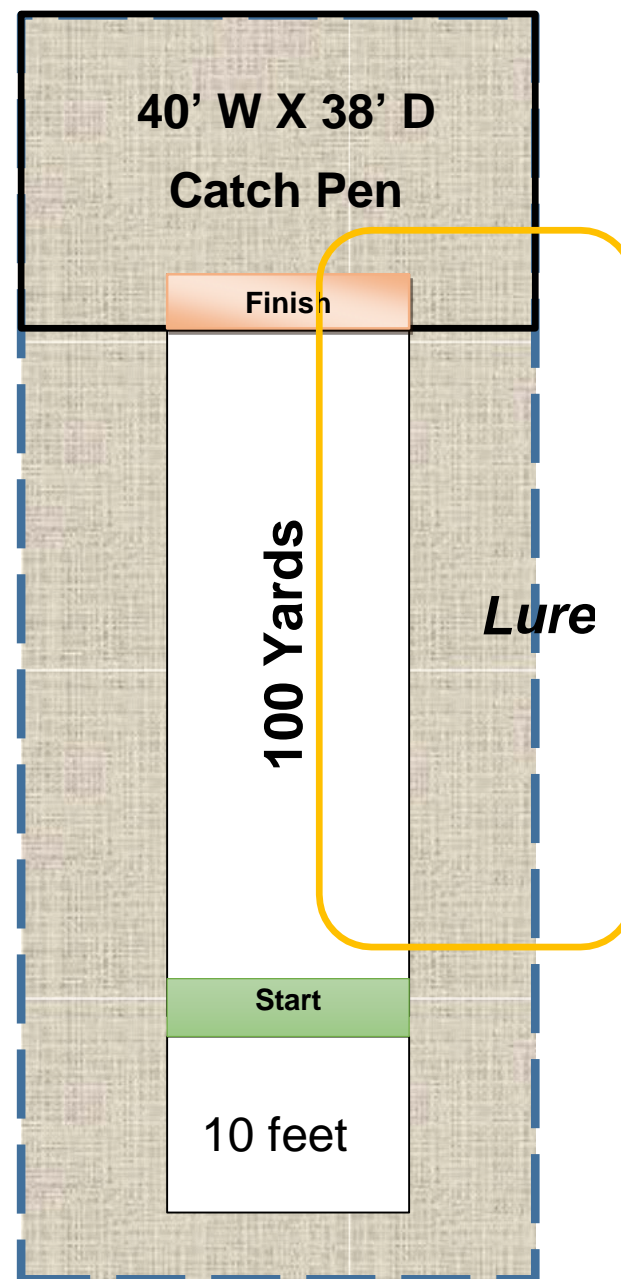
ABOUT FAST CAT

“The purpose of the AKC Fast CAT event is to provide all dogs and their owners an enjoyable, health activity in which they can participate. Dogs run singularly. The dog’s time to complete the 100-yard dash is converted into MPH. Dogs earn points based on their handicapped speed. Titles are awarded when a dog has accumulated a given number of points” – AKC Lure Coursing Website

1. Fast CAT is a timed straight 100-yard dash for dogs.
2. Dogs are held at the start line and the coursing lure is activated prompting the dog to follow chasing it to the finish line and into a catch pen. The course is completely fenced and dogs are run individually.
3. Dogs are timed when they complete the 100-yard dash. The time is converted to Miles Per Hour (MPH).
4. Based on the dog’s size at the withers a handicap is applied and points are earned:
 - 18” or greater = Handicap is 1.0
 - 12” up to less than 18” = Handicap is 1.5.
 - Below 12” = Handicap is 2.0.
5. **FORMULA: MPH X HANDICAP = POINTS**
6. Titles are earned at specific point levels and the highest suffix may appear after the dog’s name:

BCAT = 150 points
DCAT = 500 points
FCAT = 1,000 points
FCAT# = Each additional 500 points

Entries

Dogs may enter both Instinct Test and Novice class in the same trial until the dog earns the RATN title and then they cannot enter the Instinct Test.

All entries must have a barn hunt number, the exact BH registered name, be accompanied by entry fee and be signed to be valid. A returned check does not constitute a valid entry. There will be a \$25 fee for all returned checks. No entries will be taken over the phone. **Entries for Crazy 8's** will be taken on line **ONLY**. You must sign up for Crazy 8's on school web site. **Make check payable to BOSS. Send entries & fees to the trial secretary.**
Dogs must have a Barn Hunt registration number.

Move ups

If you feel that your dog will earn a title in the first trial, then you may pre-enter at the lower level and then request a move-up. Move-up forms will be available at the Secretary's table. ***Dogs completing their Senior title and wishing to move up to Masters must pay the additional \$5.00 for Masters.***

Hours & Judging Order

Friday Judging begins at 12 noon. Judging will begin no earlier than 9:00 AM on Sat & Sun. The building will open at 8:00 AM. A lunch break will be taken at judge's discretion. Trials (T) will run concurrently: Instinct T1, Novice, T1 & T2 Open T1 & T2. All lower classes will be judged in small ring. Senior T1 & T2 then Master T1 & T2. All upper classes will be judged in large ring. Height order will be reversed for the second trial of the day.

Awards

Rosettes will be awarded for first place in each height division, High in Class and new titles (*except Instinct*). Flat ribbons for all other places & Crazy 8's and qualifying ribbons for Instinct and Regular classes.

Novice - Choose 5 or 10 tricks* for your dog to perform two times:

- Bark on cue
- Crawl five feet
- Fetch & give
- Find a treat under cup
- Get a leash, brush or toy
- Get in a box
- Put 4 paws up on a low platform
- Hand signals (sit, down or come)
- High five
- Hold Object (3 seconds)
- Jump thru a hoop or over a bar
- Go in crate, stay in until released
- Give a kiss
- Put front paws on a low stool/step
- Push-ups (sit & down 3 times)
- Shake hands
- Spin in circle
- Touch hand/target stick
- Agility tunnel
- Handler's choice (2)

*If you have an AKC Canine Good Citizen (CGC) certificate your dog will perform 5 tricks. Otherwise, your dog will perform 10 tricks. Make sure you have proof of CGC at time of eval. After the evaluation, submit your Evaluation Form, AKC Title Application & \$20 to AKC to get your dog's AKC Trick Dog Title recorded!

If your mixed breed dog is not enrolled in AKC, you may apply for the Canine Partners Program when you submit your Title Application!
